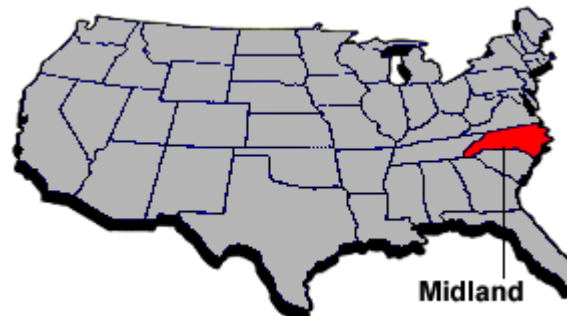

About Dogs Hope

Dogs Hope is a private, independent rescue which works with local animal control shelters to save animals when they have “run out of time.” Most of our dogs come from local North Carolina and upstate South Carolina shelters.

Our dogs are kept in foster care at the home of one of our rescuers. Many dogs come to us in need of rehabilitation. We provide basic veterinary care and special treatment when necessary.

Dogs hope receives no outside funding. We have recently been recognized as a non-profit organization by the State of North Carolina.

Dogs Hope is home to more than 30 dogs. About two-thirds of these are up for adoption. For dogs which have issues which make them not good candidates for adoption—we provide loving permanent sanctuary homes.

Donations are always welcome.

Requirements

Indoor home, with **secure outdoor exercise area**. Physical fences preferred—each dog is evaluated for exercise needs. We make every effort to custom match the needs of the family and the needs of the dog.

Pet home—our dogs are placed as pets; no hunting homes.

Crate and willingness to use crate appropriately.

Training—our dogs are started in basic training. You must be willing to continue with this.

Life long veterinary care—all of our dogs are spayed or neutered, tested for heartworms, up-to-date on vaccinations and worm medications. Adopters need to be prepared to continue with this.

Adoption Process

- If you see a dog you are interested in, fill out the online application.
- Application is evaluated, we contact you.
- References and home visit required.
- Adoption appointment scheduled.

Adoption donations: \$150 (mixes), \$250 (purebred adult dogs), purebred puppies (rare): \$350.

Donations help with spay/neuter, veterinary expenses, food, housing, and make our work possible.
