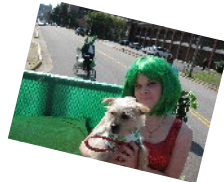

Huntsville, AL – The American Red Cross is now enrolling participants for a **Pet First Aid** class on **Sat., April 25, from 10 AM – 2 PM**. Cost of the class is \$35 and includes your choice of a dog or cat DVD and textbook. The course includes skills practice for rescue breathing and CPR on lifelike dog, cat, and puppy manikins.
