APPLICATION and 50% cash or check deposit **must** be mailed or dropped off prior to appointment. Our mailing address is P.O. Box 1254, Ocean City, NJ 08226. Actual clinic site is: 1 Shelter Road, Ocean City.

Once the shelter receives your application, you will be contacted with your appointment date. Cash balance is due when you drop off your animal that morning. **Cancellations are non-refundable.** ALL dogs **MUST** be on a leash and cats **MUST** be in carriers. Cardboard cat carriers are available at the Shelter for \$5.00 each. The animal must be picked up at the said time, same day. It is your responsibility to ensure that your animal is in good health prior to surgery. Aggressive dogs will **NOT** be accepted. As with any surgery, there are risks. It is recommended that a dog be heartworm tested and a cat feline leukemia/FIV tested prior to surgery. Heartworm positive dogs **cannot** receive surgery, Leukemia/FIV positive cats **will** receive surgery. We recommend that all animals have regular veterinary care. All dogs over 8 years old are required to have pre-op blood work done, at their own vet, prior to surgery.

I understand that the Humane Society of Ocean City is not a veterinarian's office and acts only as a satellite clinic where New Jersey State Licensed veterinarians will perform spay/neuter surgeries.

I certify that I am using this low cost clinic for my pet because I cannot afford the full price at my veterinarian's office at this time.

I RELEASE the Humane Society of Ocean City, its employees and agents, from all liability and waive any and all claims and damages, including death of the said animal. I have read "Potential Complications of Spay/Neuter Surgery on the reverse side of this form.

Surgical Consent - I am the owner or the authorized agent for the owner of the animal described above and I have the authority to execute this consent. I hereby give the Humane Society of Ocean City and any authorized agents, staff, or representatives consent and authority to perform spay/neuter surgery. I understand that this involves general anesthesia, the removal of the uterus and ovaries of females, and the removal of testicles in males. I understand what will be done. I have also been informed that there are certain risks and complications associated with any operation or procedure of this type. They have been explained to me as well. I further understand that during the course of the operations or procedures, unforeseen conditions may arise that may necessitate the performance of additional procedures. I authorize the use of appropriate anesthesia and pain relief medication as needed before or after the procedure. I have been informed that there are certain risks associated with the use of any medication. I understand that hospital support personnel will be used as deemed necessary by the veterinarian.

Potential Complications of Spay/Neuter Surgery

- Scrotal bruising and swelling in males that resolves without treatment
- Self-inflicted trauma to the surgical site. This includes suture removal by the animal, skin infections caused by licking and other damage. These problems are usually prevented by using an e-collar.
- Hematoma or seroma (non-painful swellings near the incision or in the scrotum) that resolve without treatment.
- Minor swelling and redness around the incision that resolves without treatment.
