- Spaying eliminates the possibility of uterine or ovarian cancer in females, while neutering eliminates testicular cancer and decreases the incidence of prostate cancer in males.
- Spaying and neutering makes pets better, more affectionate companions.
- Unsterilized animals often exhibit more behavioral and temperament problems.
- Spaying and neutering makes pets less likely to spray, roam, run away or get into fights with other animals.
