



The First Thing You Should Do Is Call The SPCA!

If your pet were lost, could you describe him?

1. Size
2. Ears
3. Collar & Tags
4. Special Markings (circle around eye, patches of color in key places, etc.)
5. Tail
6. Coat



Don't let your dog or cat run loose. Keep a secure collar with current I.D. on him. Walk him on a leash or keep him on a trolley or in a fenced-in yard.

If you have lost a pet, call the shelter to give a description and visit the shelter at least every other day. Don't wait for him to come home on his own—maybe he can't. *Don't assume you'll never see him again.*

The Delaware County SPCA is open for viewing lost pets from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. Sunday.
