LOW COST SPAYING AND NEUTERING PROGRAM

It's as easy as one, two, three!

- 1. CHOSE** a veterinarian on the list.
- 2. MAIL** your payment to Animal Education League.
- 3. WAIT** for your conformation letter, then make your appointment.

- Before ordering an AEL spay/neutering certificate, please call the veterinarian of your choice from the "Participating Veterinarian" list on this form to confirm his/her continued participation in the AEL spay/neuter program.
- Inform the veterinarian you intend to use an AEL spay/neuter certificate. Ask any questions you may have regarding the procedure, what is required, and if there are any additional fees.
- Amount paid includes: routine surgery, anesthesia, suture removal and overnight stay if necessary.
- The veterinarian may charge the pet owner additional fees for non-routine procedures such as:
 - pre-diagnosed infections
 - animals in estrus cycle
 - dog 50 lbs. and over
 - undescended testicles
 - pregnancy
 - age (older animals)
- All services requested unrelated to a routine spay/neuter procedure are the responsibility of the pet owner.
- Inoculations are the responsibility of the pet owner and may be required by the veterinarian and state laws.
- Please note: Veterinarians and animal hospitals participating in our program are governed and licensed by the state in which they are located. They are not owned and/or operated by Animal Education League. Should you have a problem with a veterinarian regarding a spay/neuter procedure using an AEL certificate, please contact AEL in writing.
- Certificates expire six (6) months after date of issue.
