

# TEXAS GSP RESCUE SURRENDER AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT NOTE: TGSPR's first priority, both financially and in regard to foster space, is to aid GSPs in shelters, especially those in danger of euthanasia. Consequently, TGSPR only accepts owner surrendered dogs on a limited basis. **Prior to completing this form**, you must contact TGSPR to discuss the availability of foster space for a surrendered dog. Frequently, there is a waiting list to accept owner surrendered dogs. Please be patient. There is only a waiting list when TGSPR foster space is full with GSPs accepted from area shelters.

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TGSPR asks that a family surrendering a GSP to TGSPR contribute to the vetting of a surrendered GSP if it is not a financial burden. Dogs accepted by TGSPR should be altered (spayed/neutered), current on DHPP + rabies + bordatella, heartworm tested negative within 6 months, and on monthly heartworm prevention. If your GSP does not meet these requirements, please discuss with a TGSPR Area Coordinator what the rescue's costs will be to bring your GSP current.

I understand that TGSPR or any future owner will not and is not under a duty to return the above-named GSP to me if at some time in the future I change my mind. I irrevocably relinquish to Texas German Shorthaired Pointer Rescue or its agents all rights, title and interest in and access to the above-named GSP. I hereby hold harmless and indemnify Texas German Shorthaired Pointer Rescue, its board of directors, its members, officers, agents and volunteers from all claims, demands, actions, causes of action and liability of any kind whatsoever arising as a result of or in connection with the surrender and subsequent adoption or other disposition of the surrendered GSP.
